General Biosecurity Duty

In NSW under the *Biosecurity Act 2015*, all plants are regulated with a general biosecurity duty to prevent, eliminate or minimise any biosecurity risk they may pose. Anyone who deals with any plant, who knows (or ought to know) of any biosecurity risk, has a duty to ensure the risk is prevented, eliminated or minimised, so far as is reasonably practicable

Prohibited matter

Dealing with prohibited matter is an offence. Anyone who becomes aware of or suspects the presence of prohibited matter must immediately notify the Department of Primary Industries

Prohibition on dealings

These plants must not be sold in or imported into NSW

Biosecurity zone

These plants are regulated within zones - refer to NSW WeedWise for details

Regional priority weed

These plants are regulated under Regional Strategic Weed Management Plans - refer to NSW WeedWise for details

NSW WeedWise

Visit NSW WeedWise at weeds.dpi.nsw.gov.au for information about each plant and its associated Biosecurity duties

Duty to notify on importation into the State

If a plant is not currently present in NSW, a person must not import it without notifying the Department of Primary Industries of the plant and its proposed location
