General Biosecurity Duty

In NSW under the Biosecurity Act 2015, all plants are regulated with a general biosecurity duty to prevent, eliminate or minimise any biosecurity risk they may pose. Anyone who deals with any plant, who knows (or ought to know) of any biosecurity risk, has a duty to ensure the risk is prevented, eliminated or minimised, so far as is reasonably practicable

Prohibited matter

Dealing with prohibited matter is an offence. Anyone who becomes aware of or suspects the presence of prohibited matter must immediately notify the Department of Primary Industries

If a plant is not currently present in NSW, a person must not import it without notifying the Department of Primary Industries of the plant and its proposed location
